- WHEREAS,** the governor of Illinois has declared the week of April 23-27, 2018, as "Illinois Distracted Driving Awareness Week" in the State of Illinois; and
- WHEREAS,** the City of Naperville is honored to work with many community organizations, such as AAA and Naperville School Districts 203 and 204, in raising public awareness about the perils of distracted driving.
