ORDINANCE NO. 18-____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 3 (BUSINESS AND LICENSE REGULATIONS), CHAPTER 3 (LIQUOR AND TOBACCO CONTROL), SECTION 12 (ADDITIONAL LIQUOR LICENSE RESTRICTIONS) OF THE NAPERVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPERVILLE, DUPAGE AND WILL COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, in exercise of its home rule powers that:

SECTION 1: Title 3 (Business and License Regulations), Chapter 3 (Liquor and

Tobacco Control), Section 12 (Additional Liquor License Restriction) of the Naperville Municipal

Code is hereby amended by adding the underlined language as follows:

3-3-12: ADDITIONAL LIQUOR LICENSE RESTRICTIONS:

The following are classes of liquor licenses and permits with an annual license and permit fee as indicated:

- 1. Liquor Sales and Service Hours: through
- 10. Sanitary Conditions:
- <u>11. Delivery of Alcoholic Liquor:</u> A liquor license holder licensed to sell alcohol in its original package for off premises consumption may deliver package alcoholic liquor purchased from said licensee within the City of Naperville subject to the following restrictions:

*

- <u>11.1</u> <u>Alcoholic liquor must be delivered by an employee at least twenty-one (21)</u> years of age or older.
- 11.2 Deliveries must be during prescribed hours as set forth in Section 3-3-12:1.
- <u>11.3</u> The employee that transports alcoholic liquor within the City shall not deliver or leave such deliveries without requiring a signature from the purchaser who must be aged twenty-one (21) years of age or older.
- <u>11.4</u> <u>Government issued identification establishing proof of age must be produced</u> to the delivering employee.
- 11.5 <u>A record shall be kept by the liquor license holder who delivers alcoholic liquor</u> within the City indicating the purchaser's name, address, driver's license/state identification number, time, date and place of delivery and the individual employee's identity.
- <u>All employees of liquor license holders delivering alcoholic liquor with the City</u> <u>shall meet the BASSET requirements set forth in Section 3-3-8.4</u>
- <u>11.7</u> The delivery of alcoholic liquor is limited to alcoholic liquor by the package for off premises consumption. Any liquor license holder delivering alcohol must

have a valid liquor license that authorizes the sale of alcoholic liquor by the package for off premises consumption.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval.
