C. New Business

Right of Way Transition Plan.

Andy Hynes, Engineer Manager, Department of Transportation, Engineering and Development discussed the draft update to the City of Naperville ADA Right of Way Transition Plan that was approved by the ACD in 2013. The update includes a focus on 4-way stops as recommended by the ACD in 2016. Mr. Hynes indicated that there was major update to the Plan in 2012 and a minor revision in 2013. The plan provides priorities and methods for improvements. As part of the plan there are a series of goals that were identified. The previous plan identified signalized intersections as priority locations for ADA improvements. Those are now nearly complete. They are proposing that the next priority is to make all-way stop sign controlled intersections. The process moving forward will be that the update will be presented to TAB and then to City Council for final approval.

Question from Chairman Briggs – How do you determine where to go. How do you prioritize where you work? Mr. Hynes answered that physically substandard are the first priorities. The next priority is functionally substandard. Lowest level is functionally obsolete – may have a technical issue, but not a major barrier to mobility. Focus resources on improvements with greatest impact.

Question from Commissioner Stark – What are landings? Mr. Hynes answered that a landing is where ramps intersect. Want to have it flat for turn in those locations. City approach is to be compliant with federal guidelines
