ORDINANCE NO. 19 -

ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN PROPERTY LOCATED AT 5S241 AND 5S255 TUTHILL ROAD (AKA KLA SCHOOLS)

WHEREAS, SAR Estate, Inc., 3644 White Eagle Drive, Naperville, Illinois, 60564 ("Petitioner"), and ROC/Plank Road, LLC have petitioned the City of Naperville ("City") for annexation of the real property located at 5S241 and 5S255 Tuthill Road, legally described on **Exhibit A** and depicted on **Exhibit B** ("Subject Property"); and

WHEREAS, the owner of the Subject Property is ROC/Plank Road, LLC and SAR Estate, Inc. is the contract purchaser of the Subject Property; and

WHEREAS, the Subject Property is not within the corporate limits of any municipality, but is contiguous to the City of Naperville and eligible for annexation; and

WHEREAS, all notices provided for by the Naperville Municipal Code, and all legal requirements for annexation pursuant to the provisions of 65 Illinois Compiled Statutes 5/7-1-1 *et seq.*, have been fully complied with; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Naperville has determined that annexation of the Subject Property should be approved as provided herein; and

WHEREAS, Petitioner has requested that the City approve this ordinance ("Ordinance") along with ordinances authorizing the execution of an annexation agreement for the Subject Property, approving rezoning of the Subject Property to OCI, approving a preliminary/final plat of subdivision and a platted setback deviation, and approving a variance to Section 6-9-2:4 (Off Street Parking Facilities) of the Naperville Municipal Code (hereinafter cumulatively referenced herein as the "KLA Schools Ordinances"); and

WHEREAS, Petitioner has requested that the City delay recordation of the KLA Schools Ordinances with the DuPage County Recorder for a period of time not to exceed twelve (12) months after their passage in order to allow the Petitioner to finalize the purchase and sale agreement for the Subject Property and acquire ownership of the Subject Property; and

WHEREAS, subject to approval of the KLA Schools Ordinances, the City has agreed to the proposed timeframe for their recordation with the DuPage County Recorder as set forth herein. In the event that all of the KLA Schools Ordinances are not recorded within the timeframe described above, the City and Petitioner agree that the KLA Schools Ordinances shall not be recorded and shall be deemed to be automatically null and void with no further action being taken by the City or the Petitioner; and

WHEREAS, the Petitioner and the City have fully complied with the statutory and Naperville Municipal Code requirements required for approval of the requested annexation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPERVILLE, DUPAGE AND WILL COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, in exercise of its home rule powers, as follows:

SECTION 1: The foregoing recitals are incorporated as though fully set forth in this Section 1. All exhibits referenced in this Ordinance shall be deemed incorporated and made part hereof.

SECTION 2: If recordation of the KLA Schools Ordinances does not occur within twelve (12) months after their passage and approval, then said Ordinances shall be deemed to be automatically null and void and of no force or effect without any further action being required by the Petitioner or the City. Petitioner has acknowledged that in no event shall the City be liable or responsible in any manner or for any claim if the KLA Schools Ordinances are not recorded within the timeframe described herein.

SECTION 3: Subject to approval, execution, and recordation of the KLA Schools Ordinances, the Subject Property described on **Exhibit A** and depicted on **Exhibit B** is hereby annexed by the City of Naperville.

SECTION 4: Subject to approval, execution, and recordation of the KLA Schools Ordinances the Plat of Annexation for the Subject Property, attached to this Ordinance as **Exhibit B**, is hereby approved.

SECTION 5: Upon confirmation from the City Attorney that the terms and conditions set forth or referenced herein have been fulfilled, the City Clerk is authorized and directed to record this Ordinance, together with an accurate map of the territory annexed as depicted on the Plat of Annexation for the Subject Property, attached to this Ordinance as **Exhibit B**, with the DuPage County Recorder and the DuPage County Clerk.

SECTION 6: If any section, paragraph, or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such

section, paragraph, or provision, shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance or any other City ordinance or resolution.

SECTION 7: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its recordation with the DuPage County Recorder.
