Re: **Naperville Park District's Monthly Field Report for the Riverwalk Commission Regular Meeting**

Field Report for December, 2018:

- The total amount of coins collected from the three fountains was \$1,005.00. The average collections for the past three years was \$1,090.00, so we were right on target.
- The designs for the annual flower beds have been completed, RFP's were sent to the growers and contracts now signed for the growing of 6,000 annuals. Delivery will be scheduled for the third week of May.
- The mild winter start has provided us the opportunity to cut back perennials and continue with the invasive plant removal in the Sindt Woods.
- The four light fixtures around the clock tower have been replaced with LED's.
- All of the garbage can lids were removed, brought into the shop for a thorough cleaning, and then reattached.
- Staff sent two pumps to the shop for rehab, one from the Dandelion Fountain and one from the quarry, used for irrigation.

Carillon Update – provided by Brittany Malatt (NPD)

- There are no scheduled events during January.

Other points of interest:

- The Sled hill is up and waiting for snow.
- Hockey rinks and the free skate area west of the Beach has been constructed, but due to warm temps we have yet to flood the area.
