Field Report for March, 2019:

- Many of the landscape beds have received an application of pre-emergent herbicide.
- Staff has completed the process of cutting back grasses and perennials.
- Bulbs have pushed through the soil but are not showing color, yet.
- A small volunteer group of three has started working in the Sindt Woods, removing invasives. This group will be working two to three hours every other week throughout the fall season.
- Sled hill fences have been taken down and seed and blanket will be added shortly.

Other points of interest:
