

**RESOLUTION NO. 19 - \_\_\_\_**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF THE  
INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENTS BETWEEN THE  
RIDE DUPAGE TO WORK PARTNERS**

**WHEREAS**, on November 6, 2007, the City Council of the City of Naperville adopted Resolution No. 07-066, approving the participation of the City of Naperville ("City") in the Ride DuPage to Work program; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ride DuPage to Work program currently operates under a Federal Section 5310 Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities grant secured by the City of Naperville on behalf of the Ride DuPage to Work Partners, including Naperville Township, Lisle Township, Wheatland Township, Village of Glen Ellyn, City of Wheaton, Milton Township, and Pace Suburban Bus (known collectively as the "Ride DuPage to Work partners"); who provide a 50% local match to the grant award; and

**WHEREAS**, on April 5, 2017, the City Council of the City of Naperville adopted Resolution No. 17-017, authorizing the City Manager to submit a Section 5310 Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities grant application to the RTA on behalf of the Ride DuPage partners; and

**WHEREAS**, in August of 2017, the City was awarded a Section 5310 Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities grant in the amount of \$835,692; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to begin utilizing the grant funding, the City must execute a Technical Services Agreement with the Regional Transportation Authority; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is required to sign an intergovernmental agreement as a part of the Technical Services Agreement; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPERVILLE, DUPAGE AND WILL COUNTIES, ILLINOIS**, in exercise of its home rule authority as follows:

**SECTION 1:** The City Manager and City Clerk are directed to execute the intergovernmental partnership agreement between the City of Naperville and Naperville Township, Lisle Township, Wheatland Township, Village of Glen Ellyn, City of Wheaton, and Milton Township (cumulatively referred to as “Ride DuPage to Work Partners”), attached to this resolution as **Exhibit A**, on behalf of the City.

**SECTION 2:** This resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval.
