 Minimal projected population increase in this Area will not substantially increase demand for amenities.

Recommendations

- Emphasize maintenance of existing facilities/amenities before constructing new ones.
- In the long term, develop existing parks with additional amenities if necessary.
- Look for opportunities to connect existing trails to others.
- Consider maintenance and improvements for each park based on the Service Level Guidelines outlining park maintenance standards and the Design Guidelines.
- A master planning process for Central Park improvements is planned for 2008. It will be a joint project between the City and Park District.
