Re: **Naperville Park District's Monthly Field Report for the Riverwalk Commission Regular Meeting**

Field Report for May, 2019:

- Low flow walks continue to be cleaned due to the repeated high water events.
- Weed pulling/spraying/mulching has been a high priority for the entire Riverwalk.
- Staff continues to work on turf maintenance.
- A few trees and multiple shrubs are currently being planted.
- All annual flowers have been planted and are now being monitored daily.
- The Riverwalk share of the revenue from the bulb sale is \$535.00 (40% of cost). The money is returned to the Riverwalk budget.

Carillon Update – provided by Brittany Malatt (NPD)

- The free Weekly Summer Recitals are on Tuesdays at 7:00 pm starting June 4th – August 20th. Post-recital Moonlight Carillon Tours are available from 8:00 – 8:30 pm and the cost is \$2/person.
- Weekly Carillon pops concerts will be held on Saturday evenings at 7:00 pm and Sunday afternoons at 4:00 pm beginning in June and continuing through mid-November.

Other points of interest:

- Centennial Beach and paddleboats/kayaks are now open for the season, including 'Centennial Grill'.
- The Riverwalk Café hours are Sunday through Thursday 11:00 am – 7:00 pm and Friday and Saturday 11:00 am – 8:00 pm.
