

**RESOLUTION NO. 19 - \_\_\_**

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE CITY OF NAPERVILLE'S TITLE VI PROGRAM  
FOR FEDERALLY FUNDED TRANSIT PROJECTS**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Naperville ("City") is the sub-recipient of Federal Transportation Authority funding through the Regional Transportation Authority to provide transit projects and programs, including the Ride DuPage to Work program; and

**WHEREAS**, as a requirement of the federal funding from the Federal Transportation Authority, the City must show compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 including adoption of a Title VI program; and

**WHEREAS**, Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended, requires that "no person in the United States shall, on the grounds of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance"; and

**WHEREAS**, the City provides transit services in a non-discriminatory manner and without regard to race, color, or national origin in compliance with Title VI; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Naperville has determined to adopt the Title VI program.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPERVILLE, DUPAGE AND WILL COUNTIES, ILLINOIS**, in exercise of its home rule authority as follows:

**SECTION 1:** The Title VI program attached to this resolution as **Exhibit A** is hereby adopted and approved.

**SECTION 2:** This resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval.
