AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 3 (BUSINESS AND LICENSE REGULATIONS),  
CHAPTER 3 (LIQUOR AND TOBACCO CONTROL), SECTION 3 (DEFINITIONS)  
SECTION 11 (LIQUOR LICENSE AND PERMIT CLASSIFICATIONS)  
OF THE NAPERVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPERVILLE, DUPAGE AND WILL COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, in exercise of its home rule powers that:

**SECTION 1:** Title 3 (Business and License Regulations), Chapter 3 (Liquor and Tobacco Control), Section 3 (Definitions) of the Naperville Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the underlined language and deleting the stricken language as follows:

**3-3-3: - DEFINITIONS:** For the purposes of this Chapter, the following words and phrases shall have the following meanings:

ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR through CRAFT DISTILLED SPIRITS      \*                      \*                      \*

<u>CROWLER:</u>	<u>An aluminum container containing no more than 32 ounces of craft beer or cider that is sold or offered for sale off premises.</u>
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DOWNTOWN through GROCERY STORE                                      \*                                      \*                                      \*

<u>GROWLER:</u>	A glass receptacle containing no more than two (2) liters (67.6 ounces) of craft beer or cider <del>manufactured at the licensed premises</del> that is sold or offered for sale at retail for consumption off premises.

**SECTION 2:** Title 3 (Business and License Regulations), Chapter 3 (Liquor and Tobacco Control), Section 11 (Liquor License and Permit Classifications) of the Naperville Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the underlined language and deleting the stricken language as follows:

**3-3-11: LIQUOR LICENSE AND PERMIT CLASSIFICATIONS:**

The following are classes of liquor licenses and permits with an annual license and permit fee as indicated:

<b>Container Restrictions</b>	Growler shall be sanitized, sealed with a tamper proof seal. Filled and sold by an authorized BASSET trained employee.
<b>Food Service</b>	None.
<b>Type of Liquor Service</b>	Craft beer and cider, <del>manufactured at licensed premises only.</del>
<b>Annual Fee</b>	\$1,000.00

**SECTION 4:** Title 3 (Business and License Regulations), Chapter 3 (Liquor and Tobacco Control), Section 12 (Additional Liquor License Restrictions) of the Naperville Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the underlined language and deleting the stricken language as follows:

Any liquor license authorizing the retail sale of packaged alcoholic liquor prior to the effective date of this section is exempt from this regulation unless the license is revoked, surrendered, or expired.~~
