APPROVED:

A Certificate of Appropriateness is hereby issued to authorize the demolition of the following buildings on the Property:

- Krejci Academy (619 E. Franklin Avenue)
- Gymnasium (126 N. Wright Street)*
- Administration Building (140 N. Wright Street)

*The Kroehler Mansion, also addressed at 126 N. Wright Street, is not approved for demolition.

All necessary permits are required to be submitted and approved prior to any demolition work occurring.

EXPIRATION:

October 24, 2022 - This Certificate of Appropriateness shall expire if the work authorized by this Certificate is not completed by October 24, 2022. The owner of the Property may submit a written request to the Zoning Administrator to extend the effective period of this Certificate prior to the expiration date. The Zoning Administrator may grant an extension for a period of up to two (2) additional years without reapplication to the Commission.

The application for the work summarized above was duly heard and considered by the Naperville Historic Preservation Commission at their meeting held on October 24, 2019. Partial approval was given to issue a Certificate of Appropriateness as noted in the minutes of the meeting.
