AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 3 (BUSINESS AND LICENSE REGULATIONS), CHAPTER 3 (LIQUOR AND TOBACCO CONTROL), SECTION 3 (DEFINITIONS), SECTION 11 (LIQUOR LICENSE AND PERMIT CLASSIFICATIONS)

OF THE NAPERVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPERVILLE, DUPAGE AND WILL COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, in exercise of its home rule powers that:

**SECTION 1:** Title 3 (Business and License Regulations), Chapter 3 (Liquor and Tobacco Control), Section 3 (Definitions) of the Naperville Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the underlined language and deleting the stricken language as follows:

**3-3-3: - DEFINITIONS:** For the purposes of this Chapter, the following words and phrases shall have the following meanings:

ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR through LEGAL GUARDIAN

LEGITIMATE THEATER HOUSE: A premises open to the public which provides a venue for theatrical <u>or musical</u> presentations, based on and produced in the form of a musical, dramatic, or comedic play (excluding standup comedy routines) of a <u>noncinematic nature</u> utilizing the talents of live actors <u>performers</u>.

MANUFACTURER through WINE OR VINOUS BEVERAGES \*

<u>SECTION 2</u>: Title 3 (Business and License Regulations), Chapter 3 (Liquor and Tobacco Control), Section 11 (Liquor License and Permit Classifications) of the Naperville Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the underlined language and deleting the stricken language as follows:
