### **Field Report for May, 2020:**

- Warming Shelter and Riverwalk Café bathrooms are now open.
- Low flow walks continue to be cleaned due to the repeated high water events.
- Volunteer programs have resumed on a bi-weekly basis.
- Weed pulling/spraying/mulching has been a high priority for the entire Riverwalk.
- Staff continues to work on turf maintenance.
- A few trees and multiple shrubs are currently being planted.
- All annual flowers have been planted and are now being monitored daily.
- Tulip bulb sales began online starting June 1<sup>st</sup> at [www.napervilleparks.org](http://www.napervilleparks.org). Pickup will be at the Beach on June 5<sup>th</sup> from 7:00 am – 9:00 am.

- The free Weekly Summer Recitals are on Tuesdays at 7:00 pm starting June 2<sup>nd</sup> – August 18<sup>th</sup>.
- Visitor Center and Tours are closed until further notice.
- Weekly Carillon pops concerts will be held on Saturday evenings at 7:00 pm and Sunday afternoons at 4:00 pm beginning June 6<sup>th</sup> and continuing through August 22<sup>nd</sup>.
