ORDINANCE NO. 20 - _____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE B (FIRE DEPARTMENT) OF CHAPTER 8 (MUNICIPAL DEPARTMENTS) OF TITLE 1 (ADMINISTRATIVE) OF THE NAPERVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPERVILLE, DUPAGE AND WILL COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, in exercise of its home rule powers that:

SECTION 1: Article B (Fire Department) of Chapter 8 (Municipal Departments) of Title 1 (Administrative) of the Naperville Municipal Code is hereby amended by deleting the stricken language and by adding the underlined language as follows:

1-8B-1: FIRE DEPARTMENT CREATED, MEMBERSHIP through 1-8B-3: CHAIN OF COMMAND

1-8B-4: GENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES

- 1. The Fire Department shall be responsible for preventing, extinguishing and investigating the causes of fire occurring in the City, enforcement of the provisions of this Code and all City ordinances relating to fire hazards, reporting possible violations of this Code or of any City ordinance in connection with any fire to the City Attorney. The Fire Department shall have such other duties and responsibilities as may be prescribed by law, and as may be assigned to it by the City Manager, including, but not limited to, hazardous materials response, technical rescue, underwater recovery and public education. These specified powers and duties shall apply throughout all or part of any fire district served by the Fire Department pursuant to agreement.
- 2. The Fire Department shall be responsible for maintaining and providing ambulance service within the City and within such additional areas which are to be served under contract. The fees shall be increased annually, effective January 1 of each year, beginning in 2021, without further City Council action, pursuant to

the annual report submitted for the previous year to the Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS) and/or the federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) reflecting the actual cost incurred for transport of residents and nonresidents. reimbursement rate or three percent (3%), whichever is greater. Ambulance user fees shall be assessed as follows:

- **2.1**. Each resident who is transported by ambulance shall be charged <u>a fee</u> equal to the amount listed in the cost report as outlined in Section 2, above. one thousand eight hundred dollars (\$1,800.00). A resident constitutes any person whose permanent address is within the City's corporate limits <u>or</u> within the Naperville Fire Protection District.
- 2.2. Reserved.
- 2.3. Reserved.
- **2.4.** Each nonresident who is transported by ambulance shall be <u>charged a fee equal to the amount listed in the cost report as outlined in Section 2, above. one thousand eight hundred dollars (\$1,800.00). A nonresident constitutes any person whose permanent address of residence is <u>neither within outside</u> the City's corporate limits <u>nor within the Naperville Fire Protection District.</u></u>
