RESOLUTION NO. 21-

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF NAPERVILLE TO PERFORM WORK IN THE ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S RIGHT-OF-WAY

WHEREAS, the City of Naperville (hereinafter referred to as MUNICIPALITY) located in the Counties of DuPage and Will, State of Illinois, desires to undertake, in the years 2021 and 2022, the location, construction, operation and maintenance of driveways and street returns, watermains, sanitary and storm sewers, electric lines, street lights, traffic signals, sidewalk, landscaping, etc, on State highways, within said MUNICIPALITY which highways, by law and agreement, come under the jurisdiction and control of the Department of Transportation of the State of Illinois (hereinafter referred to as DEPARTMENT); and

WHEREAS, an individual working permit must be obtained from the DEPARTMENT prior to any of the aforesaid installations being constructed either by the MUNICIPALITY or by a private person or firm under contract and supervision of the MUNICIPALITY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPERVILLE, DUPAGE AND WILL COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, that:

SECTION 1: The MUNICIPALITY hereby pledges its good faith and guarantees that the roadway shall be restored to substantially the same condition as it was originally before the MUNICIPALITY authorized construction or maintenance began, and to hold the DEPARTMENT harmless during the prosecution of the MUNICIPALITY'S work and assume all liability for damages to person or property due to the negligence of the MUNICIPALITY, its officers, agents, employees, contractors, and subcontractors for work performed under the provision of said permit.

SECTION 2: All authorized officials of the MUNICIPALITY are hereby instructed and authorized to sign said working permits on behalf of the MUNICIPALITY.

SECTION 3: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
