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AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 3 (BUSINESS AND LICENSE REGULATIONS), CHAPTER 3 (LIQUOR AND TOBACCO CONTROL), SECTION 11 (LIQUOR LICENSE AND PERMIT CLASSIFICATIONS) OF THE NAPERVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPERVILLE, DUPAGE AND WILL COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, in exercise of its home rule powers that:

SECTION 1: Title 3 (Business and License Regulations), Chapter 3 (Liquor and Tobacco Control), Section 3 (Definitions) of the Naperville Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the underlined language as follows:

3-3-3: - DEFINITIONS: For the purposes of this Chapter, the following words and phrases shall have the following meanings:

ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR through SHOPPING CENTER

SMALL BATCH WHISKEY Bourbon or rye whiskey from a craft distillery that is a smaller bottling of not more than 7,000 cases per year which results in unique flavors and characteristics among the barrels. Small bath productions represent a craft distillery's more exclusive bourbon or rye whiskeys, which are at a higher price point

SMOKING ALCOHOL INHALATION through WINE OR VINOUS BEVERAGE

SECTION 2: Title 3 (Business and License Regulations), Chapter 3 (Liquor and Tobacco Control), Section 11 (Liquor License and Permit Classifications) of the Naperville Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the underlined language and deleting the stricken language as follows:

3-3-11: LIQUOR LICENSE AND PERMIT CLASSIFICATIONS:
