Re: **Naperville Park District's Monthly Field Report for the Riverwalk Commission Regular Meeting**

Field Report for May, 2021:

- Fountains are up and running for the season.
- Volunteer programs have resumed on a bi-weekly basis. We also had a group of about 100 volunteers from Keller Williams Realty on May 13th.
- Weed pulling/spraying/mulching has been a high priority for the entire Riverwalk.
- Staff continues to work on turf maintenance.
- A few trees and multiple shrubs are currently being planted.
- All annual flowers have been planted and are now being monitored daily.
- Tulip bulb sales began online May 17th at www.napervilleparks.org. Pickup was at the Beach on May 21st.
- Installed all the spring memorial pavers, including 2 bench bricks.

Carillon Update – provided by Brittany Malatt (NPD)

- No recitals until renovations at the Carillon are completed.

Other points of interest:

- Paddleboats/kayaks are now open for the season.
- Centennial Beach is currently open for the season. Capacities are currently reduced to about 1,600 people until the next phase for opening occurs.
