**BACKGROUND:**

On December 15, 2020, City Council adopted a Human Rights and Fair Housing ordinance establishing the new Human Rights and Fair Housing Commission, defining the commission's role, powers and responsibilities. The ordinance also described processes and procedures for complaints, including hearing procedures and remedies.
