The President's Volunteer Service Award will be awarded to citizen volunteers serving police, fire and emergency management.

The President's Council on Service and Civic Participation was established in 2003 to recognize the valuable contributions volunteers are making in our communities and encourage more people to serve. The Council created the President's Volunteer Service Award program as a way to thank and honor Americans who, by their demonstrated commitment and example, inspire others to engage in volunteer service.

The awards include a President's Volunteer Service Award pin, personalized certificate of achievement and congratulatory letter from the President of the United States. The volunteer groups to be recognized are the Police's Citizen Radio Watch and Office of Emergency Managements Citizens Corps Council, Citizen Emergency Response Team and Naperville Emergency Management Agency.
