In 2018, Naperville's Senior Task Force created the Senior of the Year award as part of the task force's continued efforts to help address the unique needs of Naperville's growing senior population. The Senior of the Year award is intended to formally recognize a Naperville resident age 65 or older who has given of his or her time and talent to serve the community without expectation of acknowledgement.

Six individuals were nominated in summer 2018 for the inaugural award.
