BACKGROUND:

On August 9, 2019, the Illinois General Assembly amended the State Officials and Employees Ethics Act, 5 ILCS 430/1-1 et seq. ("Ethics Act") requiring governmental units to adopt an ordinance or resolution amending its sexual harassment policy to provide for a mechanism for reporting and independent review of allegations of sexual harassment made against an elected official of the governmental unit by another elected official of a governmental unit.

DISCUSSION:

Staff has amended the policy found in the Employee Policy Manual entitled "Prohibition and Prevention of Harassment/Sexual Harassment" to comply with the requirements of the Ethics Act. The policy has been amended to apply to all public officials, to provide a procedure for public officials to report sexually harassing conduct by another public official, and to provide for an independent review of any such reports.

There is no fiscal impact associated with passing this Resolution.
