# CITY COUNCIL AGENDA ITEM

Adopt a resolution approving the settlement agreement between John Doe by and through his guardian Carolyn Clark and the City of Naperville.

### BACKGROUND:

On April 19, 2017, the guardian of a minor child "John Doe" filed a lawsuit in the Northern District of Illinois asserting that two police officers unreasonably seized him and failed to protect him from a danger that they created and asserted a *Monell* claim against the City of Naperville alleging that it has a pattern and practice of similarly violating other's constitutional rights.

### DISCUSSION:

After the *Monell* claim was dismissed and summary judgment was granted in favor of one of the officers, the City reached a settlement with the guardian of the minor child subject to City Council approval. The attached resolution approves the settlement agreement.

### FISCAL IMPACT:

The City will make a one-time payment to the minor by and through his guardian for \$85,000.00. The City will also make a one-time payment to the minor's attorney for \$40,000.00.
